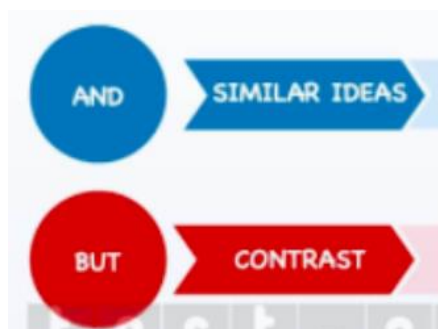

and	<u>and</u> connects two ideas that are related (I like apples <u>and</u> bananas.)	because	<u>because</u> is used to show the reason (I ate my lunch <u>because</u> I was hungry.)
but	<u>but</u> connects two opposing ideas (I have a secret, <u>but</u> I can't tell you.)	so	<u>so</u> is used to show the result (It is raining <u>so</u> I take my umbrella.)

A **conjunction** is a part of speech that is used to connect words, phrases, clauses, or sentences.
