SECOND AND THIRD CONDITIONALS

To work with the third conditional we have to use the past perfect structure.

PAST PERFECT

Past perfect is used to link an action in the past with another past action that took place later.

Past perfect is form by

had + **past participle**

She **had finished** her homework when I **called** her.

PAST PRESENT

1st action 2nd action

Once they **had heard** the explosion, they **left** the building immediately.

PAST PRESENT

1st action 2nd action

Different past perfect structures

once + **first action** , + **second action**

Once he **had washed** the dishes, he **went** to sleep.

when + **second action** , + **first action**

When we **saw** him last night, he **had** just **come** back from New York.

second action (negative) + **until** + **first action**

He **didn't take part** in the talent show until he **had rehearsed** enough.

SECOND CONDITIONAL

Impossible things in the present / unlikely things in the future
If + past simple, would + infinitive
If I won the lottery, I would sail round the world.

Things that didn't happen in the past and their imaginary results
If + past perfect, would + have + past participle
If I had studied harder, I would have passed the exam.
