### OBJETIVOS:

- Comprender el uso del pasado simple.
- Comprender oraciones en pasado simple.
- Identificar verbos regulares e irregulares.
- Identificar palabras y frases de tiempo pasado.

### USE OF SIMPLE PAST: *The Past Simple is used to write and talk about completed actions that happened in a time before the present.*

El "simple past" se utiliza para hablar de una acción que concluyó en un tiempo anterior al actual. ... El tiempo en que se sitúa la acción puede ser el pasado reciente o un pasado lejano.

Siempre se utiliza el "simple past" para referirse a **cuándo** ocurrió algo, de modo que va asociado a ciertas expresiones temporales que indican:

- **frecuencia:** *often, sometimes, always*  
I sometimes **walked** home at lunchtime.  
I often **brought** my lunch to school.
- **un tiempo determinado:** yesterday, last week (month, Monday, October,...), in 1984, ago, the day before yesterday, two hours ago, etc.
- *last week, when I was a child, yesterday, six weeks ago:*  
We **saw** a good film *last week*.  
Yesterday, I **arrived** in Geneva.  
She **finished** her work at seven o'clock  
I **went** to the theatre *last night*

#### \*un tiempo indeterminado:

- \* *the other day, ages ago, a long time ago*
- \* People **lived** in caves a *long time ago*.
- \* She **played** the piano *when she was a child*.

**Nota:** el término *ago* es útil para expresar distancia temporal en el pasado. Se coloca **después** del periodo de tiempo de que se trate: *a week ago, three years ago, a minute ago*.

### Regular and irregular verbs.

In English we have to distinguish between regular and irregular verbs.

**Examples of regular verbs: Para formar un verbo regular a tiempo pasado sólo debemos agregar "ed" o sólo la "d" si termina en "e"**

#### Infinitive / past

- Walk - walked
- Play - played
- Accept - accepted
- Live - lived

### Examples of irregular verbs: Los verbos

Drink-drank  
Go-went  
Drive-drove  
Eat-ate
