Class Objective: Practice comparatives and superlatives





• We use **comparative adjectives** to show change or make comparisons:

This car is certainly **better**, but it's much **more expensive**.

I'm feeling **happier** now. We need a **bigger** garden.

We use *than* when we want to **compare one thing** with another:

She is two years older **than** me. New York is much bigger **than** Boston. He is a better player **than** Ronaldo. France is a bigger country **than** Britain.

• We use *the* with **superlative adjectives**:

It was **the happiest day** of my life. Everest is **the highest mountain** in the world. That's **the best film** I have seen this year. I have three sisters: Jan is **the oldest** and Angela is **the youngest**.

two-syllable adjectives	more + adjective	more careful

three syllables or more	more + adjective	more dangerous more interesting		
irregular adjectives	good bad far	better worse further		

Superlatives	Spelling rule	Example
one-syllable adjectives	+ -est + -st if adjective ends in -e	the longest the safest
one syllable, ending in one short vowel + one consonant	double the last consonant + -est	the biggest
two-syllable adjectives	most + adjective	the most careful
two syllables, ending in -y	y > + -iest	the easiest
three syllables or more	most + adjective	the most dangerous the most interesting
irregular adjectives	good bad far	the best the worst the furthest
