Objectives:

Comprender el uso (concepto) del Segundo condicional.

Comprender oraciones en forma de Segundo Conditional.

Identificar auxiliary "would" y conector "if" para estructurar el 2do condicional.

Use of second conditional:

In General the second conditional is used to talk about **hypothetical** (unreal) situations.

First, we can use it to talk about things in the future that are probably not going to be true. Maybe I'm imagining some dream for example:

If I **won** the lottery, I **would buy** a big house. (I probably won't win the lottery)

If I **met** the Queen of England, I **would say** hello.

She **would travel** all over the world if she **were** rich.

She **would pass** the exam if she ever **studied**. (She never studies, so this won't happen)

Second, we can use it to talk about something in the present which is impossible, because it's not true. Is that clear? Have a look at the examples:

If I **had** his number, I **would call** him. (I don't have his number now, so it's impossible for me to call him).

If I **were** you, I **wouldn't go** out with that man.

Para formar el segundo condicional necesitamos el auxiliar "would" y el conector "if" que se traduce como "si" pero sin tilde. Ambos transforman el verbo y la oración en condicional.

Example:

If I **were** brave enough, I **would jump** from a parachute.

Si yo **fuera** suficientemente valiente, me **lanzaría** desde un paracaídas.

She **would travel** to China if she **spoke** Chinese.

Ella viajaría a China si ella hablara chino.

We **would be** more healthy if we **drink** more water.

Nosotras seríamos más saludables si bebiéramos más agua.

Short form:

If I **were** brave enough, I'd **jump** from a parachute.

She'd **travel** to China if she **spoke** Chinese.

Ella viajaría a China si ella hablara chino.
